PROJECTS

Goonininup Spring & Mt Eliza Scarp Cultural Heritage Rehabilitation

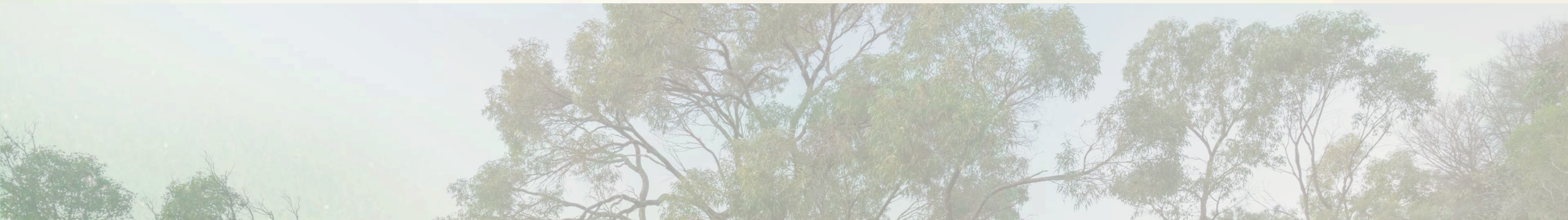
- Delivered large-scale revegetation and natural area maintenance works within the culturally significant landscapes of Goonininup Spring and the Mt Eliza Scarp in Kings Park following extensive vegetation loss.
- Works included steep scarp stabilisation, erosion control, native planting, and ongoing maintenance within environmentally sensitive and heritage-listed areas.

State Government Multi-Site Weed Control & Vegetation Management Program

- Implemented a coordinated weed control and vegetation management program across multiple wetlands, bushland reserves and river corridors on behalf the Department of Planning, Lands and Heritage.
- The program involved staged herbicide application, follow-up treatments, site inspections and reporting across numerous hectares simultaneously, with the objective of reducing long-term weed pressure and improving native vegetation health without requiring constant client oversight.

City of South Perth Urban Forest Establishment Program (2021–Ongoing)

- Provided ongoing delivery of advanced tree planting, establishment watering and maintenance services supporting the City of South Perth's Urban Forest Strategy.
- Scope included installation of advanced stock across streetscapes, parks and reserves, followed by multi-year watering cycles, pruning, inspections and adaptive management to improve survival rates and canopy growth.



PROJECTS

Nisa Road, Pinjar Landscape Restoration & Carbon Offset Program

- Delivered a multi-year, 60-hectare ecological restoration project in partnership with Greening Australia and government stakeholders focused on carbon offset outcomes and farmland rehabilitation.
- Works included broad-scale weed control, mechanical and manual site preparation, direct seeding and the staged installation of approximately 200,000 native plants.

City of Swan Drainage & Waterway Improvement Works

- Undertook erosion control, riparian revegetation and vegetation management works across drainage corridors and waterway interfaces within the City of Swan.
- Activities included bank stabilisation planting, targeted weed removal, minor civil support tasks and vegetation trimming to maintain hydraulic flow and environmental function.
